ORDER OF THE BOARD (by A. Palivos):

On August 23, 2021, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Mac's Convenience Stores, LLC (Mac's), may appeal a July 30, 2021 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.404(b), 105.406. The determination concerns Mac's underground storage tank (UST) site located at 102 East Grant Street in Coulterville, Randolph County. The Agency partially denied petitioner's request for reimbursement from the UST Fund.

The Board extends the appeal period until Tuesday, December 7, 2021, as the parties request. See 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Mac's fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
