
HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On September 16, 2021, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. The parties reported that they are discussing three options for a resolution in this matter without having to continue with a remedy hearing. The attorney for the complainant stated that a major hurdle is the fact that the Covid pandemic has interrupted the music routine at the venue and that respondents have only had “a single guy with an acoustic guitar” and not representative of pre-Covid days when bands played with amplifiers. Another problem is that complainant’s attorney has been unable to communicate with Mrs. Fiser due to the possibility of a disconnected telephone but will double his efforts moving forward. Both parties stated that they will have more to offer at the next status conference, with the possibility of complainant’s attorney opening an estate to resolve complainant status.

The parties are aware that a tentative hearing had previously been scheduled for the month October to be held at the James R. Thompson Center, and that a hearing will move forward should a resolution not be reached.

The parties are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on October 7, 2021, at 11:00 a.m. The complainant is directed to provide a call-in number.


