HEARING OFFICER ORDER


On September 23, 2021, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. Discussions centered on the Board Order of September 9, 2021 and respondent City of Morris' motion for an extension of time. (Mot.).

On September 22, 2021, The City of Morris filed a motion for extension of time to file a response to complainant's amended complaint. The Board granted complainant's motion to amend the complaint on September 9, 2021. People v. The City of Morris, an Illinois municipal corporation, and Community Landfill Company, Inc., a dissolved corporation, PCB 11-50 (Sept. 9, 2021). Pursuant to the Board's procedural rule 101.506, a response is due within 30 days. Mot. at 1. The City of Morris requests an additional 60 days to respond. Mot. at 1-2. Complainant has no objection. *Id.* The motion is granted and The City of Morris' responsive pleading is now due on or before December 9, 2021.

The parties also reported that they have resumed discussions regarding a possible resolution to the enforcement matter.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to appear at a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on December 16, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing. The complainant will provide the call-in number.


