On November 17, 2021, Freedom Oil Company (Freedom Oil) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns an application for reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Fund for Freedom Oil's leaking UST site located at 957 West Reynolds Street in Pontiac, Livingston County. On December 4, 2017, Freedom Oil filed a petition for review of a determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency partially denying Freedom Oil's request for reimbursement.

The Board grants Freedom Oil's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
