
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Van Wie):

On June 26, 2018, the complainant, James Fiser, filed a citizen’s enforcement noise complaint against respondents James A. Meador and Henry’s Double K, LLC. (Henry’s), a bar and music venue in Mount Carroll, Carroll County. On March 11, 2020, a hearing was held. On January 21, 2021, the Board issued an interim opinion and order.

On December 10, 2021, the parties jointly submitted an agreed order to the hearing officer, stating that “the parties have entered into a Settlement Agreement satisfactory to both parties.” See December 13, 2021 HOO. “[B]y joint consent, the parties have requested the dismissal of this action, with prejudice.” *Id.* The Board construes this submission as a joint motion for voluntary dismissal with prejudice. The Board grants the parties’ joint motion for voluntary dismissal with prejudice and closes the docket.
