
**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

On December 16, 2021, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. The parties reported that they continue settlement discussions and have had meetings with the new Mayor of the City of Morris to brief him on this enforcement matter. The parties anticipate another meeting with the Mayor in early 2022. Due to the status of the settlement discussions, the City of Morris requested another extension of time to February 28, 2022, to answer or otherwise plead to complainant’s amended complaint. Complainant has no objection.

The motion for extension is granted and the City of Morris’ answer or other pleading is now due on or before February 28, 2022.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to appear at a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on January 27, 2022, at 11:00 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing. The complainant will provide the call-in number.


