
HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On January 20, 2022, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. The parties were advised that respondent's motion for summary judgment was taken under consideration by the Board. Complainant indicated that he may file a motion for leave to file a sur-reply to respondent's reply to complainant's response to the motion for summary judgment. Complainant also inquired that he is entertaining the thought of requesting oral argument. *See* Board procedural rules 101.700. It is noted that if complainant intends to proceed with his sur-reply, it is now past due and any sur-reply will have to be accompanied by a motion for leave to file a belated sur-reply directed to the Board. *See* Board procedural rules 101.500. A request for oral argument is to be directed to the Board.

The parties are reminded that complainant's motion to amend the complaint and respondent's motion for summary judgment is at present being considered by the Board.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on March 29, 2022, at 10:30 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, including a call-in number, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


