On February 22, 2022, Cady Oil Company (Cady Oil) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Fund for Cady Oil's leaking UST site located at 206 West Jackson Street in Morton, Tazewell County. Cady Oil filed the petition for review of a November 20, 2019 determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency denying part of Cady Oil's request for reimbursement. The Board grants Cady Oil's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
