ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.F. Currie):

On December 16, 2021, at the parties' request, the Board extended until March 9, 2022, the time period for 7-Eleven, Inc. to appeal a November 1, 2021, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The determination concerns 7-Eleven Inc.'s underground storage tank (UST) site located at 2702 Avenue of the Cities in Moline, Rock Island County. The Agency partially denied petitioner's request for reimbursement from the UST Fund. Because 7-Eleven, Inc. failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
