ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. Gibson):

On March 29, 2022, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Happy's Super Service may appeal a February 23, 2022, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.404(b), 105.406. The determination concerns Happy's Super Service's underground storage tank (UST) site located at 101 East Dakota in Spring Valley, Bureau County. The Agency partially denied petitioner's request for reimbursement from the UST Fund for Incident-Claim No. 20141324-72465.

The Board extends the appeal period until Tuesday, July 5, 2022, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Happy's Super Service fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
