The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") has reviewed Union Pacific Railroad's June 8, 2022 request for a provisional variance pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b). Based on this review, a provisional variance for a period of 30-days is GRANTED by the Illinois EPA.

The applicable facts of this request are as follows:

- 1. Due to delays I getting the profile approved and planning for transportation of the waste, Union Pacific Railroad ("UPRR") requests a 30-day extension to send the waste to Clean Harbors in Texas to their incineration facility.
- 2. The disposal facility is not able to accept the waste until June 29, 2022 and other facilities nearby are unable to accept this amount of liquid waste, 1200 gallons of Sodium Hypochlorite at this time.
- 3. The 90-day accumulation period for the Sodium Hypochlorite has an end date of June 20, 2022. June 20, 2022 being a State and Federal Holiday, the end date becoming June 21, 2022.
- 4. UPRR states that this is a one-time extension, and no previous extension has been requested for this waste.
- 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b) allows a generator to seek an extension of up to 30 days by means of a provisional variance from the Illinois EPA if hazardous waste must remain on-site for longer than 90 days due to unforeseen, temporary, and uncontrollable circumstances. The Illinois EPA

finds that such facts and circumstances exist in this situation and hereby GRANTS LANXESS a provisional variance pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b) for a period of 30 days.

UPRR shall sign a certificate of acceptance of this provisional variance and return it to Melanie A. Jarvis #21 at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276 on or before June 21, 2019. The certification should take the following form:
