NARRATIVE INSPECTION REPORT DOCUMENT

GENERAL REMARKS

On May 19, 2022 an open dumping and open burning inspection was conducted at 2129 N 44th Rd Sheridan, IL by Ms. Lauren Grumieaux, Mr. Brian Gift, and Ms. Myranda Posada representing the LaSalle County Land Use Department, under the delegation authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. The property is owned by Gerald Copeland.

Weather conditions on May 24, 2022 were overcast and 65 °F. Winds E at 14 mph.

Ms. Grumieaux, Mr. Brian Gift, and I arrived at the site at 12:05 PM and began the inspection.

Prior to the inspection, Ms. Grumieaux, Mr. Gift, and I went to Mr. Gerald Copeland's other property, T. Copeland Special Needs Trust, to see if Mr. Copeland was on the property. As we stood in the driveway, Mr. Gerald Copeland's son made his way onto the property from the roadway. After a quick introduction Mr. Adam Copeland called his father. Mr. Gerald Copeland then made his way to the driveway from the barn. We informed Mr. Gerald Copeland that we received a complaint from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency regarding open burning and open dumping.

We asked Mr. Copeland if he would take us to the site; Mr. Copeland denied. He stated that he was not open burning, or open dumping, and refused to show us the property. After discussing the situation with Mr. Copeland, he obliged to take us to his property. Mr. Gift, Ms. Grumieaux, and I then made our way back into the vehicle where we then followed Mr. Copeland and his son to the property. Once at the property, we viewed scrap metal on the southwestern portion of the property. (Photo #1) On the same side, we viewed a tractor tire, more scrap metal along with metal piping comingled with wooden post. (Photo #2) Continuing on, we documented the open burn pile. (Photo #3) Facing southwest, we noted a truck tool box filled with metal poles, a rusted wagon, and other miscellaneous debris. (Photo #4) We also documented a tire filled with stagnant water while on the property. (Photo #5) Facing south to the open burn pile, we noted landscape waste, rusted miscellaneous items eroding from the ground, and charred debris. (Photo #6) Continuing south, we documented a tree growing through farming equipment, along with more metal items and black tubing. (Photo #7) Viewing the open burn pile, tire wire was present in the pile. (Photo #8) As we documented our findings, we also noted burned metal wire and landscape waste were present. Facing southwest, we could view a half-burned tire with wire protruding out. (Photo #9-#10)


As we made our way around the open burn pile, Ms. Grumieaux and I noticed small scraps of metal strewn throughout the property. We also noted wooden post, miscellaneous metals piled in the open burn pile as well. (Photo #11- #12) Heading southeast, there was a tire laying on top of the burn pile. As we looked closer, we could see that previous tires have been burned, due to the tire wire protruding out of the open burn pile. (Photo #12-#14) On the west end of the property we documented more pieces of metal and miscellaneous debris eroding from the ground. Mr. Copeland stated to us that he did not plan to burn the items in the pile. He also stated that due to his property being a prior junk yard, that is the reason why so many items are coming up from the ground due to

him excavating the property. He also stated that he was excavating the property because he was cleaning up the site.

After documenting our findings, we returned to the vehicle and concluded the inspection at 1:08 PM.








