ORDER OF THE BOARD (by A. Palivos):

On May 12, 2022, at the parties' request, the Board extended until August 5, 2022, the time period for ExxonMobil Oil Corp. (Exxon) to appeal a March 30, 2022 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The determination concerns Exxon's proposed corrective action plan (plan) and corrective action budget (budget) with respect to free product from leaking underground storage tanks (UST) at the site located at 1701 West Harrison Street in Maywood, Cook County. The Agency rejected both the plan and the budget.

Because Exxon failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
