<u>PCB 21-29</u>	People of the State of Illinois v. LMS Industries, LLC and Top Metal Buyers, Inc. (Air, Land, RCRA – Enforcement) – Upon receiving a stipulation, a proposed settlement, and an agreed motion for relief from the hearing requirement in this enforcement action concerning Top Metal and LMS' scrap metal recycling facility in St. Clair County, the Board directed the Clerk to provide the required newspaper notice of the settlement-related filings.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 22-24</u>	People of the State of Illinois v. Khalid Siddiqui, d/b/a Citgo Gas Station (Air – Enforcement) – The Board granted the People's unopposed motion to deem facts admitted and for summary judgment. The Board therefore found that Siddiqui violated Section 9(a) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/9(a) (2020)) and Sections 218.586(i)(1)(B) and 218.586(i)(2)(C) of the Board's air pollution regulations (35 III. Adm. Code 218.586(i)(1)(B), 218.586(i)(2)(C)), as alleged in the People's complaint. The Board also ordered Siddiqui to pay a \$10,000 civil penalty.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 22-45</u>	<u>Stericycle, Inc. v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (Land – Permit Appeal) – The Board granted Stericycle's motion to voluntarily dismiss its appeal concerning its incinerator facility in Dewitt County.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 22-48</u>	People of the State of Illinois v. St. Mary Fuel Co. d/b/a Clark (Air – Enforcement) – In this enforcement action concerning a Cook County gas station, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2020)), accepted a stipulation and proposed settlement, and ordered St. Mary Fuel to pay a \$5,000 civil penalty and to cease and desist from further violations.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 22-62</u>	People of the State of Illinois v. Cores for You, Inc. and Precision <u>Foundry Tooling, Ltd.</u> (Water, Land, RCRA – Enforcement) – In this enforcement action concerning a site in Hancock County and another in Hamilton County, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2020)), accepted a stipulation and proposed settlement, and ordered Cores for You and Precision Foundry Tooling to pay a \$20,500 civil penalty and to cease and desist from further violations.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 22-66</u>	Brandis Aircraft v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Land, RCRA – Permit Appeal) – Because Brandis Aircraft failed to file a petition during the extended appeal period, the Board dismissed the case and closed the docket.	5-0 roll call vote

<u>PCB 22-83</u>	People of the State of Illinois v. Ibrahim Mubarak, individually and <u>d/b/a Gulf</u> (Air – Enforcement) – The Board granted the People's unopposed motion to deem facts admitted and for summary judgment. The Board therefore found that Mubarak violated Section 9(a) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/9(a) (2020)) and Sections 218.586(i)(1)(B) and 218.586(i)(2)(C) of the Board's air pollution regulations (35 III. Adm. Code 218.586(i)(1)(B), 218.586(i)(2)(C)), as alleged in the People's complaint. The Board also ordered Mubarak to pay a \$10,000 civil penalty.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 23-12</u>	<u>Aqua Illinois, Inc. v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (Permit Appeal – Public Water Supply) – The Board granted Aqua's motions to voluntarily withdraw its permit appeal as to Additional Conditions 3, 4, and 5, and therefore denied as moot the Agency's motion to dismiss as to those conditions. The Board also denied the Agency's motion to dismiss the appeal as to Additional Condition 6.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 23-15</u>	PQ LLC v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Permit Appeal – Air) – The Board granted PQ's motion to stay the contested permit condition.	5-0 roll call vote

Mahalaxmi LLC (Air – Enforcement) – In this enforcement action concerning a Cook County gas station, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2020)), accepted a stipulation and proposed settlement, and ordered Mahalaxmi to pay a \$5,000 civil penalty and to cease and desist from further violations.	5-0 roll call vote

Lake Petroleum Inc.</u> (Air – Enforcement) – In this enforcement action concerning a McHenry County gas station, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2020)), accepted a stipulation and proposed settlement, and ordered Lake Petroleum to pay a \$5,000 civil penalty and to cease and desist from further violations.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 23-34</u>	People of the State of Illinois v. PPC Flexible Packaging, LLC (Air – Enforcement) – The Board accepted the People's complaint for hearing concerning PPC Flexible Packaging's flexographic printing facility in Lake County.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 23-35</u>	People of the State of Illinois v. 3803 Roosevelt LLC, d/b/a BP (Air – Enforcement) – The Board accepted the People's complaint for hearing concerning BP's gas station in Cook County.	5-0 roll call vote
