### **Preliminary Matters**

On September 27, 2022, petitioner filed a motion *in limine* (Mot.) seeking to exclude any references, testimony, or argument at hearing relating to the following two documents relative to Additional Condition No. 6: "Email from David Cook dated November 5, 2021 with Kankakee and Iroquois River nitrate data and related emails," R 000581-000600, and (2) "Kankakee WTP TP01 Nitrate," R 000602," because they were only first included in the complete record that was filed on September 23, 2022, and not the prior "Amened Record" filed on August 26, 2022, and September 2, 2022. *See* Mot. at 3-4. Petitioner's motion was denied at hearing on September 28, 2022. Transcript at 10-11.
