The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") has reviewed Illinois Air National Guard's January 25, 2023, request for a provisional variance pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b). Based on this review, a provisional variance for a period of 30-days is **GRANTED** by the Illinois EPA.

The applicable facts of this request are as follows:

- 1. The Illinois Air National Guard is a Small Quantity Generator of hazardous waste, with its contracted disposal facility located in Kentucky, over 200-miles away, and therefore subject to a 270-day accumulation time limit.
- 2. The 270-day accumulation time limit for one of its 2.5-gallon pails of waste ends January 28, 2023. The Petitioner is required to use the Defense Logistics Agency ("DLA") for disposal of hazardous waste and has attempted to process the container through the DLA on July 27, 2022, October 12, 2022, and December 14, 2022. However, incinerator backlog has prevented the inclusion of the container in previous shipments.
- 3. The removal of the 2.5-gallon pail of hazardous waste was to occur on January 24, 2023, but pick-up for delivery to the disposal facility was delayed beyond January 28, 2023, due to damage to the delivery truck. Pick-up is being rescheduled for removal from the site before February 28, 2023.
- 4. Illinois Air National Guard states that this is a one-time extension, and no previous extension has been requested for this waste.

35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b) allows a generator to seek an extension, of up to 30 days by means of a provisional variance from the Illinois EPA if hazardous waste must remain on- site for longer than 90 days due to unforeseen, temporary, and uncontrollable circumstances. The Illinois EPA finds that such facts and circumstances exist in this situation and hereby **GRANTS** a provisional variance pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.ll7(b) for a period of 30 days.

The Illinois EPA grants this provisional variance in accordance with its authority contained in Sections 35(b), 36 (c), and 37(b) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/35(b), 36(c), and 37(b)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b). The decision to grant this provisional variance is not intended to address compliance with any other applicable laws or regulations.
