Pulte Home Company, LLC</u> (Water, NPDES – Enforcement, Citizen) – In this citizen's enforcement case alleging water violation in DuPage County, after complainant failed to timely file the required proof of service as directed by the Board in a February 16, 2023 order, the Board dismissed the case and closed the docket.	3-0 roll call vote

<u>PCB 23-57</u>	Paul Christian Pratapas v. Chelsea Manor by M/I Homes (Water, NPDES – Enforcement, Citizen) – In this citizen's enforcement case alleging water violations in DuPage County, the Board granted in part respondent's motion to dismiss as frivolous, provided the complainant 30 days to amend his complaint to remedy identified deficiencies, and denied the motion to dismiss on other grounds.	3-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 23-93</u>	People of the State of Illinois v. Conagra Foods Packaged Foods, <u>LLC</u> (Air, CAAPP – Enforcement) - In this enforcement action concerning a Coles County facility, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2020)), accepted the parties' stipulation and proposed settlement, and ordered Conagra Foods Packaged Foods, LLC to pay a civil penalty of \$17,500 and to cease and desist from further violations.	3-0 roll call vote
