<u>JURISDICTION</u>

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2022).

FACTS

- 1. That Rome and Sokpheap Keith are the present owners and Rome Keith is the present operator of a property located at 908 Madison Street, Keithsburg, Mercer County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Keithsburg/Keith Rome.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1310155011.
 - 3. That Respondents have operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.

- 4. That on March 23, 2023, Caleb Froidcoeur of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Peoria Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 5. That on May 18, 2023, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7012 0470 0001 2969 5049 to Rome and Sokpheap Keith.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Caleb Froidcoeur during the course of his March 23, 2023 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2022).
- (2) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2022).
- (3) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2022).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2022), Respondents are jointly and severally subject to civil penalties of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars</u> (\$4,500.00). If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalties specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>June 27, 2023</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2022), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2022), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondents' check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield,

Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2022). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

On March 23, 2023, I (Caleb Froidcoeur, BOL/FOS – Peoria) investigated citizen's complaint 6144 at 908 Madison St., Keithsburg, Illinois. The complainant alleged that the City of Keithsburg was allowing the property owner, Mr. Rome Keith, to burn and demolish his house. The complainant mentioned that there are some buildings in Keithsburg that are more than 100 years old, and asbestos may be a legitimate concern at this property. According to records found at the Mercer County Office of the Recorder, the site's PIN is 13-13-26-116-001, and it is a residential property owned by Rome and Sokheap Keith. The most recent deed was recorded on December 17, 2020 (document number 2020-400943). The investigation took place from 10:53 a.m. – 11:15 a.m. Apparent violations were observed.


Evaluation Narrative

Prior to the inspection, I contacted the complainant to ask questions and gather additional information regarding the site. The complainant explained that the resident burned the house, and the fire department was not using it for practice. The complainant mentioned that to the best of his knowledge, a person named Rome Keith owns the property.

I arrived at the site at 10:53 a.m. No one was present on-site at the time of the inspection, despite the burn pile actively smoldering, so I commenced the inspection. I immediately observed a large burn pile (see photographs 1, 2, 4-14, and 17) containing a mixture of general construction and demolition debris (GCDD), municipal solid waste, and suspected asbestos (see photograph 6). During the inspection, I observed a nearby tree that was charred several feet high (see photographs 15 and 16). This likely indicates that the building was burned before it was demolished. At 11:15 a.m., I concluded the inspection and departed the property. Apparent violations were observed.
