FACTS

- 1. That Respondent, Daniel & Shirley Partridge is the present owner of property located in Manlius Township, LaSalle County, Illinois.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump site, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Permit, and is designated with Site Code No. 0998175009 Said facility is commonly known to the Agency as Four-Star Campground.
- 3. That the Respondent has owned the said facility since February 9th, 2007.
- 4. That on August 29, 2023, Lauren Grumieaux and Myranda Lakan of the LaSalle County Department of Land Use, under the authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection reports setting forth the results of such inspections are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

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5. On the basis of direct observations of Lauren Grumieaux and Myranda Lakan of the LaSalle County Department of Land Use, it has been determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping at the above-described facility in a manner which results in the following occurrences:

CIVIL PENALTY

- 6. Pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/42 (b) (4), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1042 (b) (4), Respondent herein is subject to a civil penalty of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) for each violation specified above in Paragraph 5(b) for a total of Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7500.00). Additionally, should Respondents elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described herein below, and if there is a finding of the violation alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board, in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollar (\$1500.00) statutory penalty for each finding of violation.
- 7. If you acknowledge the violations cited herein above, the civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than thirty-five (35) days from the date of service hereof. If you do not petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board of review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of service hereof or if you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, any judgment rendered against you shall specify the due date of the statutory civil penalty and any costs assessed against you.
- 8. When payment is made, one certified check or money order for (\$3,750.00) shall be made payable to the **LaSalle County Treasurer** and mailed to:

If any civil penalty imposed by the Illinois Pollution Control Board is not paid within the time prescribed in the order, interest from such penalty will be assessed for the period from the date payment is due until the date payment is received. If any civil penalty, by reason of acknowledgment, default, or finding after the adjudicatory hearing is not paid when due, the LaSalle County State's Attorney may initiate proceedings in Circuit Court to collect said civil penalty. In addition to the previously assessed civil penalty, interest and hearing costs of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, if any, the State's Attorney's Office will seek to recover their costs of litigation.

NARRATIVE INSPECTION REPORT DOCUMENT

GENERAL REMARKS

On August 29, 2023, an open dump and open burn re-inspection was conducted at 2776 E 2625th Rd., Marseilles, IL by Ms. Lauren Grumieaux and Ms. Myranda Lakan representing the LaSalle County Land Use Department, under the delegation authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.

Weather conditions on August 29, 2023, were 85°F wind WNW at 11mph

Ms. Grumieaux and I arrived at the property at 2:58 PM and began the re-inspection.

Ms. Grumieaux contacted Mr. Partridge via cell phone and let him know of our arrival. After making our way to the northern portion of the parcel, Mr. Partridge met with us on the property. First, we addressed the burn pile that was located on the neighboring property (Outback#1). Mr. Partridge stated that they had removed the items from the pile and cleaned the area. The neighboring property was clean and free of waste at the time of the inspection. Next, we viewed the miscellaneous items being stored in the area. Tanks, chicken wire, plastic pallets, trailers, a snow blower, tires, metal fencing, and other accumulated items were viewed. (Photo #1-#2) Ms. Grumieaux noticed accumulated water in one of the waste tires located in the area. She asked that the tires either be recycled or stored inside. (Photo#3)

Next, Mr. Partridge led us to the northeastern portion of the property. Once out of the vehicle, we documented the area. Piles of demolition debris were viewed throughout. An employee was cutting the frame of a demolished trailer with at torch at the time of the inspection. Looking south, I documented more tires, a television, a trailer frame, and a partly demolished trailer. (Photo#4) Looking to the east, I documented the materials in the piles. Demolition waste, furniture, electronics, mattresses, tires, windows, doors, cabinets, sinks, white goods, car parts, and other domicile waste were scattered throughout the area. (Photos #5- #9) Multiple trailers and waste had been removed from the area since the last inspection. Mr. Partridge pointed out the location where the dumpster had been. He stated that he had saved the receipts from the landfill as requested. Mr. Partridge added that, if need be, he could hire more help with the cleanup process. He then asked for a time frame of when the site would need to comply. Ms. Grumieaux stated that he had already long exceeded his 90 days, but would discuss the photos with Mr. Brian Gift (Director of the Land Use Department) and go from there. Mr. Partridge explained that the trailers viewed were left on the property by the original owners. To dispose of the trailers, he pays an employee to demolish them. The scrap metal is separated from the waste (both scrap metal and waste were piled throughout the site).

After documenting our findings, Ms. Grumieaux stated that the next location we needed to view was Outback #2. Mr. Partridge stated that they had recently added wood, and charred materials from a recent fire to the area. He explained that he planned to have the fire department come out a perform a

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controlled burn in that location. Mr. Partridge did not accompany us for the remainder of the inspection.

Once at Outback number 2, I noted that the pile on the hillside had grown in size since the previous inspection. I documented charred debris and a burned deck in the area. (Photo #10) Continuing east, I viewed paneling, demolition waste, carpeting, lattice, and other household items in the pile. (Photo #11- #15) After gathering our notes, we left the area.

Lastly, we viewed the ravine near the pond. After exiting the vehicle, I documented domicile waste near the creek. Further east, I viewed the ravine. Household items, trash, clothing, yard decor, and more domicile waste were viewed along the hillside and creek bank. (Photo #16-#18) After documenting our findings, Ms. Grumieaux and I concluded the inspection at 3:20 p.m.


