Mr. Halloran. thank you for your email. We are concerned about a six week delay when very simple alternatives are available that will allow this matter to proceed tomorrow morning as scheduled:

- Mr. Pratapas found a way to email the Board, meaning that he found both internet access and the electricity needed to send the email;
- We can call his cell (which is battery operated) and you at the scheduled time; this does not require him to have electricity in his apartment;
- We understand that Mr. Pratapas moved to Memphis to work for a unit of local government. The call is scheduled during normal business hours. If he can't charge his phone at home, he should be able to do so at work, OR we could call him at his work number and join you to the call;
- To the best of our knowledge, Memphis is not experiencing a catastrophic power failure; any difficulties Mr. Pratapas may face are local and most likely of his own making.

We filed a comprehensive motion to dismiss, along with supporting materials, on June 21, 2023; we filed a reply brief in support of that motion on July 21, 2023. You probably noted that on October 24, we filed our brief in opposition to Mr. Pratapas' motion to amend the complaint yet again.

This matter has dragged on for a considerable amount of time. All work on the project was completed early last summer. Mr. Pratapas missed three prior status calls, did not respond to any of our discovery requests (including requests for admission), and failed to disclose any witnesses or identify any documents supporting his claims.

With all due respect, our client deserves to get this matter resolved and behind them. We ask that the call proceed tomorrow morning as scheduled.
