West Chicago, as you know is a community with a significant Latino population, and has been specifically chosen for two waste sites. We question why other municipalities, particularly those predominantly white and affluent, are not being targeted instead. Promoting this site is beneficial only to a broader, whiter, and wealthier group of cities that surround us. This will have a direct impact in our city, our environment, the traffic we will receive and the value of our properties. We were excluded as Hispanics because there were no Spanish translation services in the audiences that were opened to discuss this matter which we see as discriminating against us.

I am completely opposed to the construction of this second dumping site. Our proposal is that instead it should be installed elsewhere in a way that is equitable for every city and township in the western suburbs of Chicago.
