ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.F. Currie):

On October 11, 2023, the County of LaSalle (County) filed an administrative citation (Citation) against Daniel Partridge, Shirley Partridge, and Four-Star Campground (collectively, Respondents). *See* 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2022). The administrative citation concerns a property located at 2776 East 2625th Road in Marseilles, LaSalle County. The property is commonly known to the County as the "Four-Star Campground" site and is designated with Site Code No. 0998175009.

The County alleged that on August 29, 2023, respondents violated Sections 21(p)(1), 21(p)(2), 21(p)(3) and 21(p)(7) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), (p)(2), (p)(3), (p)(7) (2022)) by causing or allowing the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, scavenging operations, open burning, and deposition of general construction or demolition debris or clean construction or demolition debris. The County notes that the alleged violation of Section 21(p)(1) is a subsequent violation. AC at 4, 5; see County of La Salle v. Daniel Partridge, Shirley Partridge, and Four Star Campground, AC 23-09 (May 18, 2023) (finding violation of Section 21(p)(1) and assessing statutory penalty of \$1,500). The County provided personal service of the citation on October 6, 2023. Citation at 8.

On November 1, 2023, the County filed a motion to dismiss the administrative citation. (Mot.) In the motion, the County says that the Respondents have subsequently paid the civil penalty amount pled by the Citation. Mot. at 1. The Board has previously granted a complainant's motion to dismiss an administrative citation where the Respondent had paid the pled civil penalty amount in full prior to the deadline to file a petition to contest the citation. *See* County of LaSalle v. Pamela Shanley, AC 22-2 (Feb. 17, 2022). Therefore, the Board grants the County's motion, dismisses this case, and closes the docket.
