ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M.D. Mankowski):

On January 30, 2024, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Aero Plating Works may appeal a January 10, 2024 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency denied a request to modify the closure plan for Aero Plating Works' plating facility located at 1860 North Elston Avenue in Chicago, Cook County.

The Board extends the appeal period until Thursday, May 16, 2024, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Aero Plating Works fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
