Dear Mr. Fisher:

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") has reviewed your February 20, 2024, request for a provisional variance pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b). Based on this review, a provisional variance for a period of 30-days is **GRANTED** by the Illinois EPA.

The applicable facts of this request are as follows:

North American Lighting in Flora, IL (EPA ID# ILD980901953) requested additional time because a single 55-gallon drum, dated December 6, 2023, missed their regularly scheduled shipment. Their next shipment is scheduled for March 19, 2024, and this drum must be shipped by March 6, 2024.

35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b) allows a generator to seek an extension of up to 30 days by means of a provisional variance from the Illinois EPA if hazardous waste must remain onsite for longer than 90 days due to unforeseen, temporary, and uncontrollable circumstances. The Illinois EPA finds that such facts and circumstances exist in this situation and hereby **GRANTS** a provisional variance pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b) for a period of 30 days.

As specified at 35 Illinois Administrative Code 722.134(b), the purpose of this letter is to request an additional 30 days for accumulation of hazardous waste at the North American Lighting facility in Flora, IL (EPA ID# ILD980901953). Additional time is requested because a single 55-gallon drum, (dated 12/6/23) carrying a D001 code, missed our regularly scheduled shipment on 2/7/2024. Due to the 90-day storage rule, this drum must be shipped out by 3/6/2024. Our next scheduled shipment is 3/19/2024.
