## ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD NOTICE OF HEARING

The Illinois Pollution Control Board gives notice of public hearing regarding rule changes proposed by the Board on March 7, 2024: National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS), USEPA Amendments (July 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023), R24-15. Interested persons are invited to attend the hearing or to submit written comments. The docket R24-15 would update the Illinois ambient air quality requirements to correspond with amendments to the federal National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQSs) that the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) adopted during the second half of 2023. The proposed amendment it will ultimately result in submission to the USEPA of an amendment to the state implementation plan (SIP). Section 110(a)(2) of the Federal Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. §7410(a)(2) (2023)) requires reasonable notice and hearing before a state undertakes an amendment to the SIP. Interested persons are invited to attend the hearings or to submit written comments. The Public Hearing will be held on April 18, 2024, at 11:30 a.m. at the Michael A. Bilandic Building, Room N505, 160 N. LaSalle Street, Chicago, Illinois and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Building, Illinois Pollution Control Board Hearing Room, Room 1244N, First Floor 1021 North Grand Avenue East, Springfield, Illinois. The hearing is subject to cancellation without notice and may be confirmed by calling the Office of the Clerk at 312/814-3461.
