The Illinois Pollution Control Board gives notice of public hearing regarding rule changes proposed by the Board on March 7, 2024: National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS), USEPA Amendments (July 1, 2023, htrough December 31, 2023), R24-15. Interested persons are invited to attend the hearing or to submit written comments. The docket R24-15 would update the Illinois ambient air audity requirements to correspond with amendments for the federal National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQSs) that the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) adopted during the second half of 2023.
