Summary and purpose of amendments: The following briefly describes the subjects and issues involved in this rulemaking. A comprehensive description is contained in the Board's opinion and order of May 16, 2024, adopting amendment in docket R24-6. The docket R24-6 proceeding relates to the wastewater pretreatment requirements in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 307 of the Illinois water pollution control rules.

The amendment to Illinois rules that are "identical in substance" (IIS) to wastewater pretreatment regulations adopted by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) during the first half of 2023. USEPA amended the effluent limitation guidelines for the steam electric power generating point source category to extend the date for existing coal-fired power plants to submit a notice of planned participation (NOPP) for the permanent cessation of coal combustion subcategory in the 2020 Steam Electric Reconsideration Rule. The Board adds the extended NOPP deadline to the Illinois sewer discharge criteria rules for steam electric power generating.

Section 13.3 of the Environmental Protection Act [415 ILCS 5/13.3] provides that Section 5-35 of the Administrative Procedure Act [5 ILCS 100/5-35] does not apply to this rulemaking. Because this rulemaking is not subject to Section 5-35 of the APA, it is not subject to First Notice or to Second Notice review by the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules (JCAR).
