The Illinois Pollution Control Board gives notice of public hearing regarding rule changes proposed by the Board on June 6, 2024: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code Subtitle B (Air Pollution), R18-21. Interested persons are invited to attend the hearings or to submit written comments. If adopted by the Board, the Agency intends to submit the following to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for approval as State Implementation Plan (SIP) revisions 1) The Agency's proposed changes to 35 Ill Adm Code 211, 215,217, 218, 219, 225.407, and 225.507 as revisions to Illinois' ozone SIP; 2) The Agency's proposed changes to 35 Ill Adm Code 212 and 225.307 as revisions to Illinois' fine particulate matter SIP; 3) The Agency's proposed changes to 35 Ill Adm Code 214 as revisions to Illinois' sulfur dioxide SIP, 4) The Agency's proposed changes to 35 Ill Adm Code 216 as revisions to Illinois' carbon; monoxide SIP and 5) The Agency's proposed changes to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 201 as a general revision to Illinois' SIP. The submittal will include an analysis demonstrating that the proposal does not interfere with attainment or maintenance of any applicable National Ambient Air Quality Standard, reasonable further progress, or any other applicable requirement of the Clean Air Act This notice is intended to satisfy the requirements of Section 110(1) of the CAA, 42 U. S. C. §7410(1) (public notice for SIP revisions) Interested persons are invited to attend the hearings or to submit written comments. The Public Hearing will be held on October 3, 2024, at 9:00; at the IPCB Hearing Room, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, North Entrance, Springfield, Illinois; and November 7, 2024, at 9:00 am at the Michael A. Bilandic Building, Hearing Room N505, 160 N. LaSalle Street, Chicago, Illinois.
