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# RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE TO PETITIONER'S MOTION TO STAY

Now comes Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ("IEPA"), by KWAME RAOUL, Attorney General of the State of Illinois, and pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.522, hereby moves for an extension of time until September 6, 2024, in which to file Illinois EPA's response to Petitioner's, RCH NEWCO II ("RCH Newco"), Request to Stay. In support of this filing, Illinois EPA states as follows:

- On July 19, 2024, Petitioner filed its Petition to Appeal Illinois EPA's Final
   Determination ("Petition") and Request to Stay ("Request to Stay") with the Illinois Pollution Control
   Board ("Board").
  - 2. On July 19, 2024, Illinois EPA received RCH Newco's Petition and Request to Stay.
- 3. On July 23, 2024, the Illinois Attorney General's Office received Illinois EPA's request for representation in the above-captioned matter.
- 4. Pursuant to Section 101.500(d) of the Board Procedural Rules, 35 Ill. Adm Code 101.500(d), a party may file a response to a motion within 14 days after service of the motion. Therefore, Respondent's response to the Request to Stay would have been due by August 2, 2024.
- 5. Pursuant to Section 101.522 of the Board Procedural Rules, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.522, if a party's motion shows good cause, the Board or hearing office may extend any deadline required by this part.

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6. Due to unforeseen circumstances, the AGO is currently reviewing the relevant documents and information for purposes of filing its response to the Request to Stay.

- 7. The Petition is on the Board's August 8, 2024 Meeting Agenda ("Agenda").
- 8. Although the Agenda does not indicate that the Request to Stay is before the Board at this time, out of an abundance of caution, by this filing, Respondent informs the Board and RCH Newco that it requests an extension of time to file a response to the Request the Stay.
