



NOTICE OF HEARING

The Illinois Pollution Control Board gives notice of public hearing regarding rule changes proposed by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency on July 8, 2024: Amendments To 35 Ill. Adm. Code 217, Nitrogen Oxides Emissions, R25-17. Interested persons are invited to attend the hearings or to submit written comments. If adopted by the Board, the Illinois EPA will submit the proposed amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 217 relating to the control of nitrogen oxides emissions from various source categories to the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("USEPA") for review and approval as a revision to Illinois' State Implementation Plan ("SIP") to address the reasonably available control technology requirements for nitrogen oxides under Sections 172 and 182 of the Clean Air Act ("CAA"), 42 U.S.C. §§ 7502 and 7511a, for major stationary sources in areas designated as nonattainment with respect to the 2015 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard ("NAAQS"). The Illinois EPA will also submit to USEPA the proposed amendments to Part 217 relating to sources affected by the October 27, 1998, NOx SIP Call, including existing reciprocating internal combustion engines not located in the above nonattainment areas, for review and approval as a revision to Illinois' SIP concerning the SIP Call. The revisions submitted to USEPA will include amendments to current regulatory provisions as well as an analysis demonstrating that the proposal does not interfere with attainment or maintenance of any applicable NAAQS, reasonable further progress, or any other applicable requirement of the CAA. This notice is intended to satisfy the requirements of Section 110(l) of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. § 7410(l) (public notice for SIP revisions). Interested persons are invited to attend the hearings or to submit written comments. The Public Hearing will be held on Thursday, September 26, 2024, beginning at 10:00 AM by VIDEO CONFERENCE at the Madison County Circuit Court, 155 N. Main Street, Third Floor, Edwardsville, Illinois AND IPCB Hearing Room, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, North Entrance, Springfield, Illinois;..... SECOND HEARING: Thursday, November 21, 2024, beginning at 10:00 AM by VIDEO CONFERENCE at the Michael A. Bilandic Building, 160 N. LaSalle Street, Room N 505, Chicago AND the IPCB Hearing Room, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, North Entrance, Springfield, Illinois. The hearings are subject to cancellation without notice and may be confirmed by calling the Office of the Clerk at 312/814-3461.
