NOTICE OF PROPOSED STIPULATION AND PROPOSAL FOR SETTLEMENT OF ENFORCEMENT CASE. The Attorney General has brought a case against Inland-Frycek, Inc. for violating State pollution control rules. On July 17, 2024, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing. Any person who would like to comment on, or demand a public hearing on, the stipulation and proposal for settlement may do so by filling a written comment or hearing demand with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the publication of this notice.
