
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. A. Van Wie):

On November 13, 2024, the City of Springfield, Illinois (City) timely filed a request (Req.) to extend the 35-day period within which the City may appeal an October 10, 2024 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency issued a new Special Exception Permit for Monthly Operating Permits to the City’s drinking water department in Springfield, Sangamon County. The request reports that the Agency does not object to the requested extension. *See* Req., Att. 2.

The Board extends the appeal period until Thursday, February 13, 2025, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a); *see also* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(a) (accounting for State holiday for Lincoln’s birthday). If the City fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
