Please docket this for public comment regarding the Proposed Clean Car and Truck Standards: Proposed Section 35 III. Admin. Code 242 and R2024-017.

Thank you for receiving my public comment. I reside in Joliet, zip code 60404. I support the Illinois Pollution Control Board adopting the proposed Clean Car and Truck Standards.

Here are the reasons that I support these rules:

- Justice for warehouse workers
- Truck pollution and noises
- Vibrations from trucks - Shaking + weakening
- Low wages. Costs keep going up but not wages
- Access to housing - Houses being destroyed for Warehouse development. Now there is a housing shortage or people being displaced. More people being homeless cause of displacement or not being able to pay their bills, losing their license, Secretary of State does not accept motel addresses for our registration or driver's licenses.
- Roads. All deplorable - constant construction everywhere
