ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. Gibson):

On January 15, 2025, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which The Breaking Point, Inc. (The Breaking Point) may appeal a December 9, 2024 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.404(b), 105.406. The determination concerns The Breaking Point's underground storage tank (UST) site located at 1855 West Willow Road in Northfield, Cook County. The Agency partially denied The Breaking Point's request for reimbursement of \$18,366.93.99 from the UST Fund covering the period of June 5, 2023, to September 30, 2024.

The Board extends the appeal period until Tuesday, April 15, 2025, as the parties request. See 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If The Breaking Point fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
