Pre-Filed Questions

Due to the Presidents' Day Holiday on February 17, 2025, the deadline for filing written questions to the witnesses will be pushed back one day. Pre-filed questions are now due on February 18, 2025.

Public Comment

On March 10, 2025, from 1 p.m. to 2 p.m., an hour will be set aside for in-person public comment during the hearing. On March 11, 2025, from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m., two hours will be set aside for virtual public comment via Webex. Members of the public who wish to comment inperson in Springfield on March 10 will be able to sign up at the hearing on a first-come, first-served basis. Those who wish to comment on-line will need to request a time slot by emailing <u>vanessa.horton@illinois.gov</u>. The deadline for requesting a time slot is March 3, 2025, at 5 p.m. A schedule of virtual public comments will be set on March 5, 2025 via hearing officer order. Participants indicated they anticipate a large number of public comments, so the hearing officer will cap each comment at two or three minutes per comment, depending on the number of commenters.

Please note that the Board weighs oral and written public comment equally. Members of the public are encouraged to submit written comments. The Board will continue to accept written comments through the post-hearing written comment deadline, which will be set at a later date.
