


ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING, FEBRUARY 26, 1971
189 W. MADISON STREET, CHICAGO

Mr. Currie convened an emergency meeting of the Board to consider the necessity for taking immediate action, due to the imminent expiration of the statutory 90-day deadline, in #70-40, City of DuQuoin v. EPA. He reported that the recommendation of the EPA, just received by telephone, stated that the petition had never been filed with the Agency. Therefore, Mr. Currie said, the 90-day period had not begun to run and there was no need for emergency action. The meeting was thereupon adjourned. Mr. Kissel and Mr. Lawton were in attendance.
