MINUTES OF INFORMAL BOARD MEETING
July 19, 1971 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Parties in #70-7 et al, League of Women Voters v. NSSD, presented oral argument on the City of Highland Park's motion to reopen the case.

In #71-80, Monyek and #71-85, Wagnon, variance petitions with regard to the sewer ban in the North Shore Sanitary District were denied. Messrs, Kissel and Aldrich dissented in #71-85. Mr. Dumelle will file a concurring opinion in #71-80. The Board voted 5-0 to adopt Mr. Dumelle's opinion and order in #71-83, National Starch.

Discussions of opinions and orders for the following cases were held: ##71-24, Hyman-Michaels; 71-32, Denny; 71-48, Golconda; 71-49, Ashbaugh; 71-128, City of Zion.

##70-21, Dresden and 71-20, Quad-Cities were discussed.

A report from the Institute on the status of projects and future Board needs was reviewed.

Pending rule-making matters, including R70-8, Effluent Standards and R70-11, Open Burning were discussed.
