Minutes of Regular Board Meeting
July 26, 1973 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

R72-2, Noise Regulations were discussed and adopted with some amendments to the proposed final draft by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Lawton will prepare an Opinion for possible adoption July 31, 1973.

Mr. Lawton announced that the Board meeting scheduled for August 2, 1973 would be held on July 31, 1973.
