MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
March 21, 1974 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: ##73-2, Denny; 73-552, Vena; 73-559, International Harvester; 73-560, Potter; 73-563, -564, Mobil Oil.

The Board voted 4-1 to request the Attorney General's Office to enforce the Board order in #72-464, C.B.E. v. Joliet et al. Mr. Henss dissented. Mr. Dumelle said that he would write a letter to the Attorney General requesting enforcement.

Motion for extension of time in #71-308, Martin was allowed 5-0. Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

Motion to dismiss in #72-270, Marblehead Lime was held to March 28, 1974 pending receipt of Agency response.

Motion for extension of time to post performance bond in #73-54, Texaco was allowed 5-0. Mr. Seaman will prepare an order.

The Agency indicated that motions for hearings filed in ##73-264, Carlyle and 73-288, Highland would be withdrawn. The Board took no action.

Motion to dismiss in #73-447, Near Ones v. Carlson was ordered taken with the case by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

Motion to amend order in #73-511, Litho-Strip was allowed 5-0. Mr. Seaman will prepare an order.

Motions to dismiss in #73-514, National Phosphate and #74-77, Hammond Organ were assigned to Dr. Odell for review and ordered place on the agenda for March 28, 1974.

Motion to amend in #74-20. C.B.E. v. Circuit Etchings was denied 5-0. Motion for special finding was held to March 28, 1974. Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

Motion to dismiss in #74-27, Olin Corp. was denied 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

R73-15, W. Q. S. Amendments, petition to intervene by Olin was referred to Mr. Henss as hearing officer for a ruling.

The Board decided that there was no need for a further hearing date in R73-13, Public Water Supply.

The Board asked to be notified when the mandate in #72-97, Nilles is filed by the Appellate Court.

Minutes of Board Meetings held February 21 and March 14, 1974 were approved by a vote of 5-0.

In citizen enforcement cases these actions were taken: ##74-83, Rutland EPA v. Board of Supervisors et al, motion to dismiss allowed and motion to amend allowed 5-0, Mr. Henss will prepare an order. Oral argument was set for April 4, 1974 at 2:00 P.M.; #74-85, Hromec v. Lakeland Park Water was held to April 4, 1974; #74-87, C.B.E. v. Commonwealth Edison, the Board voted 3-2 to ask parties to file briefs; Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order. Mr. Marder and Mr. Seaman dissented.
