MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
December 5, 1974 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Mr. Dumelle introduced Mr. Philip Zeitlin, a recently appointed Board Member.

The opinion in R73-11 and R73-12, NPDES was adopted by a vote of 5-0.

An opinion and order was adopted in #73-113, Union Electric by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Henss not present.

Opinions and orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ##73-514, National Phosphate; 74-231, Leroy; 74-265, Benj Harris; 74-321, Aurora; 74-333, Union Oil; 74-368, Early & Daniel (interim order).

Opinions and orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-1: ##73-551, Republic Steel; 74-335, Olin. Mr. Henss dissented in both cases.

Joint motion for extension of time in #72-81, Tee-Pak was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

An order was adopted on a motion for modification in #72-466, Rail-to-Water by a vote of 5-0. Dr. Odell will prepare an order.

Motion for hearing in #74-105, CBE v. Lauhoff Grain was allowed by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Motions to withdraw were granted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ##74-324, Tri-County Landfill and 74-343, St. Charles. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the orders.

Motion for continuance was granted in #74-326, Haag Labs by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the order.

Joint motion for cancellation of hearing in #74-358, FS Services was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the order.

Motion to strike in #74-395, Chillicothe was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the order.

Motion for disposition without hearing in #74-408, Sherwin-Williams was granted by a vote of 5-0. Dr. Odell will prepare an order.

Proposal for WQS amendments by the Illinois Petroleum Council was ordered authorized for hearing and consolidated with a similar proposal filed by Republic Steel (R74-15).

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held to December 19, 1974.
