Minutes of Regular Board Meeting  
November 15, 1979 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Interim Orders were adopted in #78-232, Wyanet and #78-293, Ralston-Purina, by a vote of 3-1, Dr. Satchell dissented.

An Interim Order was adopted in #78-299, Quincy Foods, by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Werner may file a Supplemental Statement.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0: ##78-300, Archer-Daniels-Midland; 79-29, Olin; 79-120, Stanadyne (Opinion only); 79-123, Zeigler Coal; 79-170, Village of Fisher; 79-178, Round Lake Park.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #79-43, American Hoechst, by a vote of 3-0. Mr. Werner abstained.

An Order was adopted in #79-155, Farmers and Merchants Bank, by a vote of 3-1, Mr. Werner dissented.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #79-193, Nadelhoffer-Wilson, by a vote of 3-1, Mr. Werner dissented.

A Resolution and Order was adopted in R79-12, New Source Performance and Hazardous Emission Standards, by a vote of 3-0, Mr. Werner abstained.

Motion to reconsider in #78-215, Knoxville, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to strike brief in #78-256, Danekas, was dismissed as moot by a vote of 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted granting a motion for stay in #78-289, Interlake, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to substitute record in #79-61, Illinois Power, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for continuance in #79-159, Algonquin Public Library, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw in #79-213, Sulllivan, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.
