MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING APRIL 26, 1990 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

All Board Members were present. Chairman Marlin called the meeting to order and introduced new staff member Dr. LouAnn Burnett who will be assigned to the Board's Scientific/Technical Section.

Board Member R. Flemal presented a draft Opinion in #AC 89-18 (Dockets A & B), J & R Landfill. Thereafter, Board Member Flemal moved for separate votes on Counts A, B, C, and D, which were recorded as follows: Count A: motion to amend by J. Anderson and seconded by J. Dumelle failed by a 3-4 vote with J. Anderson, J. Dumelle and M. Nardulli for it and R. Flemal, B. Forcade, J. Marlin and J. Theodore Meyer against it. Count A was then adopted by a vote of 4-3 with J. Anderson, J. Dumelle and M. Nardulli dissenting; Counts B and D: motion to substitute alternate language by J. Marlin and seconded by J. Dumelle carried by a vote of 4-3 with J. Anderson, J. Dumelle, J. Marlin and M. Nardulli for it and R. Flemal, B. Forcade and J. Theodore Meyer against it; Count C was adopted by a vote of 7-0 with J. Anderson concurring. Thereafter the matter was tabled until May 10, 1990.
