A Resolution was adopted in R81-16, Docket B, New Source Review, by a vote of 5-0. The Resolution was proposed to allow a draft Opinion and Order to be circulated for public comment prior to adoption.

R81-17, Combined Sewer Overflow Rules was adopted as a Final Opinion and Order by a vote of 5-0.

An Order was adopted in #78-177, Celotex, requesting briefs on the motion to issue a permit. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.
