An Interim Order was adopted in R80-22, SO_2 , for Winnetka, by a vote of 4-0.

A Proposed Rule, Second Notice and Proposed Opinion was adopted in R81-16, Docket B, Air Permits, by a vote of 4-0.

A Final Opinion and Order was adopted in R81-29, Pfizer, by a vote of 4-0.

A Resolution and Order was adopted on R83-13, New Source Performance Standards, by a vote of 4-0.
