All Board Members were present. Mr. Dumelle introduced Mr. J. Theodore Meyer, who was recently appointed to the Board. Mr. Meyer abstained from participating in the discussion of pending matters or decisions.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #80-31, Burns v. Western Springs, by a vote of 3-0. Mrs. Anderson abstained.

## 82-115 and 83-30, General Motors, was discussed and held for decision pending some legislation.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0: ## 83-10, Frink's: 83-31, Mendota; 83-41, Frink's v. Rockford, Mr. Dumelle concurred; 83-42, Norris City; 83-48, Lockport.

In R81-30, Trade Secrets, a Proposed Opinion and Proposed Rule, Second Notice, was adopted by a vote of 4-0.

In R83-6, Docket B, Mine Amendments, an emergency rule was adopted by a vote of 4-0.

Motion to amend in #78-247, Continental Grain, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #79-180, Caterpillar, was held to the next meeting for consideration.

In #82-111, Modine, a motion for continuance was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In #82-132, 133. Will County, motion of counsel to withdraw was granted. Motions for interlocutory appeal and for extension of time were held pending receipt of the transcript of hearing. The vote was 4-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

The Board decided that no action was needed on a request to clarify in #83-70, Shelbyville. The petitioner's attorney indicated an amended petition would be forthcoming.

In # 83-21, Oak Grove, a motion to extend time for filing a recommendation was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to correct Order in R80-22,  $SO_2$ , was held to the next meeting for consideration.

These matters were discussed and held to another meeting for consideration: #79-167, Continental Grain; 82-21, Galesburg; 83-9, Mt. Olive; R79-14, Chapter 2 Revisions; R82-27,-36, Procedural Rules Revisions; R83-9, Algicide Permits.

In new cases these actions were taken by a vote of 4-0: ## 83-77, Tuscola, additional information requested, Order by Mr. Dumelle; 83-78, EPA v. Illinois Central R.R., hearing mandatory; 83-79, Rheem Manufacturing, hearing authorized.

In #83-80, Texaco, a provisional variance was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle and Mrs Anderson concurred. Mr. Nega will prepare the Opinion and Order.

R83-14, G.D. Searle Site Specific WQS amendment, was authorized for hearing and publication by a vote of 4-0.

Revisions to the regular meeting schedule were adopted as follows: The Board will meet on July 14 and 26, August 18, September 8 and every other Thursday after that.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held for possible consideration on July 14, 1983.
