MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
October 6, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present save Mr. Meyer who was attending a conference out-of-state.

An Interim Order was adopted in #83-2, Chemetco, by a vote of 4-0.

An Order, dismissing the case was adopted in #83-101, Calumet City by a vote of 4-0.

Orders were adopted in these matters for codification: R81-7, Solid Waste and R81-9, Special Waste. The vote of 4-0.

A Final Order was adopted in R81-26, John Deere, by a vote of 4-0.

A Proposed Rule, First Notice and Proposed Opinion were adopted in R82-3, Alton Water Company by a vote of 4-0.

A Final Order and Final Opinion were adopted in R82-31, Forging Noise, Dockets A, B and C, by a vote of 4-0.

A Final Order was adopted in R83-6, Mine Waste (Docket B), by a vote of 4-0.

A Proposed Rule, Second Notice Order was adopted in R83-9, Algicide Permits by a vote of 4-0.

A motion for final continuance in #80-38, Bacon's Farm, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to join a party in #83-71, Bourbonnais, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #83-83, Joslyn, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to extend an Order in #83-85, Browning-Ferris, was ordered taken with the case.

Motion to withdraw in #83-113, Bennett, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Pursuant to the objections filed in #83-124, Citizens Utilities, a hearing was authorized.

Minutes as amended were approved for September 8 and 23, 1983 by a vote of 4-0.


The Board decided to reschedule the Board meeting set for November 17, 1983 to November 18, 1983.
