MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
November 3, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

#79-142, Citizens Utilities was discussed and held to November 18, 1983 for possible decision.

A Final Opinion and Order was adopted in R81-30, Trade Secrets, by a vote of 5-0 in #82-16, Steel v. Beucher. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

A joint motion to dismiss in #82-102, Mt. Carmel, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #82-154, Moline, pursuant to a motion for an interlocutory appeal. The vote was 5-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion for continuance in #83-22, Standard Scrap, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order

Motion for modification in #83-62, Effingham, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Nega will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw in #83-87, Velsicol, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for additional time in #83-105, Ford Motor, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to strike recommendation in #83-107, Quaker, was denied by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Meyer dissented. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

A motion to correct in R82-19, RCRA, was construed as a new rule-making and assigned R83-24. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Dumelle concurred. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of public comment in R83-17, Stage II, Vapor Recovery, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

R83-22, New Source Performance Standards, was adopted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

A petition to amend the Water Regulations filed by Tuscola. R83-23, was authorized for hearing and publication.

Mr. Dumelle announced that Bill Forcade and John Marlin had been confirmed by the legislature as Board members.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held to November 18, 1983 for possible consideration.
