MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
November 18, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present. Chairman Dumelle introduced Bill Forcade and John Marlin who had been recently appointed to the Board.

In #83-76, Village of Seneca, an Opinion an Order was adopted by a vote of 6-0, Mr. Marlin abstained.
