MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING

January 12, 1984 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #79-142, Citizens Utilities by a vote of 7-0. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Forcade concurred.

A Proposed Rule, Second Notice was adopted in R82-3, Alton Site Specific, by a vote of 7-0.

R82-15, Emission Reduction Banking, was dismissed by a vote of 7-0.

Motion to dismiss in R83-19, Shell Oil, was granted by a vote of 7-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In #83-25, Department of the Army, a Second Motion for modification was granted by a vote of 7-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In #83-163, Bittle, motion to dismiss was denied and motion to join parties was granted by a vote of 7-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time to file an amended petition was granted in #83-166, Mobil, by a vote of 7-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to appear in #83-173, Industrial Salvage, was granted by a vote of 7-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In #83-233, Thrall Car, petitioner was granted leave to file an amended petition in the nature of a permit appeal instead of a variance. The vote was 7-0, Mr. Forcade will prepare an Order.

A Proposal regarding Algicide Amendments filed by Applied Biochemists was ordered held for possible consideration on January 26, 1984.

The Board then agreed to amend the starting time of all regular Board meetings through June 30, 1984 to begin at 10:30 A.M. unless otherwise announced.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held to January 26, 1984 for possible consideration.
