March 21, 1984 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present. Chairman Dumelle asked for a moment of silence in memory of Board Member Donald Anderson.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 6-0: #80-49 East St. Louis School District; 83-24, Shell Oil; 83-40, Oakbrook Utility; 83-177, Prairie Vista; 84-16, Metropolitan Sanitary District, Mr. Dumelle concurred.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #83-147, Lombard, by a vote of 5-1, Mr. Forcade dissented. Mrs. Anderson will prepare the final Opinion and Order.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in ##83-228,-229,-230, St. Charles et al. v. Kane County Board et al., by a vote of 4-2, Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Forcade dissented.

A Proposed Opinion was adopted in R84-1, Permit and Inspection Fees, by a vote of 4-2. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Meyer dissented.

A Proposed Order was adopted in R84-5, Illinois Contingency Plan, by a vote of 6-0.

Motion for stay in ##82-103,-104, Illinois Power, was denied by a vote of 6-0. Mr. Meyer will prepare an Order.

A request to reverse and motion for extension in #82-154, Moline, was Ordered taken with the case.

Motion to dismiss in #83-17, Bliss, was denied by a vote of 5-1, Mr. Meyer dissented. Mr. Forcade will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #83-66, Nauvoo, was granted by a vote of 6-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for rehearing in #83-79, Rheem, was denied by a vote of 6-0. Mr. Forcade will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #83-111, Johnson and Johnson, was granted by a vote of 6-0. Mr. Forcade will prepare an Order.

Motion for continuance in #83-122, Jennison-Wright, was granted by a vote of 4-2. Mrs. Anderson and Mr. Meyer dissented. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to reconsider in #83-225, Beardstown, was denied by a vote of 6-0. Mr. Nega will prepare an Order.

Motion to reconsider in R84-1, Permit and Inspection Fees was denied by a vote of 4-1. Mr. Meyer abstained and Mr. Dumelle dissented. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

A second amended petition was requested in #84-6, Monmouth, by a vote of 6-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

A second amended petition was requested in #84-27, German Valley, by a vote of 6-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.


